This has led to the development of multiple dyslipidemia guidelines—while these documents differ with respect philosophy and complexity, they are more similar than they are different. This presentation aims to explore three recently published dyslipidemia guidelines with the goal of deriving a few pragmatic considerations that participants can apply in practice.
