



CSHP-BC Branch Physical Assessment Course Reimbursement Procedure

Each course participant may receive reimbursement from CSHP-BC Branch **after** the successful completion of the CSHP-BC Branch Physical Assessment Course for Pharmacists at Langara College Main Campus in Vancouver or Royal Jubilee Hospital in Victoria. Pre-requisite for the course is licensed pharmacists who are in active practice in BC with an opportunity to practise physical assessment skills at their workplace. The reimbursement is supported by the College of Pharmacists of BC and is subjected to fund availability on an annual basis. Active CSHP members will be given an extra \$100 discount.

- 1) Each successful participant will complete and submit the *CSHP-BC Branch Physical Assessment Course Reimbursement Claim Form* to the CSHP Office in Ottawa.
- 2) The participant must include a copy of the certificate of course completion from Langara College along with the Reimbursement Claim Form to the CSHP office in Ottawa.
- 3) The CSHP office will issue a cheque for the reimbursable amount as per Claim Form.

Travel Grant

Individuals residing outside of the Greater Vancouver Regional District (GVRD) for the Vancouver course and in Duncan or further north for the Victoria course may apply for a travel grant through CSHP-BC Branch to partially cover the travel expenses related to the Physical Assessment course. The funding is available on a first come first served basis.

- 1) One month prior to starting the Physical Assessment Course for Pharmacists, eligible participants must complete the [CSHP-BC Branch Physical Assessment Course for Pharmacists Travel Grant Application](#) and submit via email to CSHP BC Awards Chair: awards@cshp-bc.com.
- 2) The applicant must ensure the travel grant has been approved prior to starting the course. The onus is on the applicant to participate in the course even if the travel grant application has been denied.
- 3) CSHP-BC Branch Awards Chair will provide the names of the travel grant recipients to the CSHP office.
- 4) After successful completion of the Physical Assessment Course, the participant will complete and submit the *CSHP-BC Branch Physical Assessment Course Reimbursement Claim Form* to the CSHP office in Ottawa as per above.
